Our evaluation goal & question:

 Does the SFOEC program promote safety and comfort in the outdoors for the populations that we serve?

Broader question/idea:

 Does the SFOEC program increase access to the outdoors for socioeconomically and racially diverse families?







Our proposed data collection methods:

- Pre/post student assessments
 - Written
- Student Focus group
- Coding responses

Our evaluation timeline:

September- Try it!
October- Review data, reflect on methods
November- evaluate data collection tools, Coding
April- Try it again
May- Review data, reflect on methods
June- Share results in grant reports

Pilot Study

- Surveyed 200 4th Grade students from Title I Santa Fe Public Schools
- Combined 3 methods: Individual reflection, Partnered Discussion, Group Share
- Method designed for 9 year olds with varying English literacy and accounting for social dynamics

2 Turn + Talk


what are 3 words that best describe how you felt while outside today?

Plans for our results:

- Code the data
- Include results in grant reports to funders
- Share with other SFOEC partner orgs and teachers
- Reflect as a team, and an organization about how to make the outdoors more diverse and safe
- Incorporate results into curriculum design, more longitudinal studies?
- Share the experience of evaluation with the rest of our organization in hopes of embedding it into our work more
