

How to do a Wordle

1. Only can be done in Firefox
2. Look for Wordle.net
3. Copy text (In the examples we used raw data, before coding, which we had in an Excel file, although it can be copied and pasted from a word file). We did a Wordle for each question (the answers to each question).
4. In the word document we made all the words lower case
5. We separated the words with a tilde (~) (looks like an “eñe” in Spanish) by going into Edit find and replace: Find space- you just click to leave a space) and replace with the ~ symbol)
We chose the top 40 to 50 words to avoid clutter and to be able to read easily.

I think the best thing about a Wordle is that when you show it to a group of participants they may see what they said. You can also compare it to your coding and themes to make sure you did not miss something important even though it may not have been repeated often.
