Our proposed data collection method(s):

- Alumni Focus Groups
- Students were interviewed and filmed
- We then coded the information and pulled out similar themes of
 - Mentorship, being seen, self discovery, being welcomed, sense of home, self expression, promotion, happy, health, community building, stability and safety.

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Our evaluation timeline:

- Yearly
 - We intend on doing a yearly focus group with different students and ask similar questions about the impact Moving Arts has had on their lives.
 - We did this type of evaluation this year during a leadership training weekend and received amazing results.
